# 2. Report on Personal Protection Equipment (PPE) Grant

The grant in the amount of \$500 was used to purchase a standalone, touchless sanitizing gel dispenser, a countertop touchless sanitizing gel dispenser and sanitizing gel refills.

# 3. Report on Back to Books Grant

The grant in the amount of \$4900 is being used to purchase Wonderbooks (a print book with a ready-to-play audiobook inside), Playaways (a pre-loaded audiobook), and Launchpads (a preloaded tablet that doesn't require WIFI). These items are geared to children and young adults aged pre-school through 8<sup>th</sup> grade.

## 4. Cards for Kids Act

This "Amends the Illinois Local Library Act and the Public Library District Act of 1991. It provides that <u>nonresident fees</u> for the privilege and use of a library <u>shall not be charged to a nonresident</u> in an unincorporated area in Illinois <u>who is a student and meets the poverty income guidelines."</u>

This legislation has passed and is effective immediately.
